CALIFORNIA PROPOSITION 65 COMPLIANCE

Valued Customers,

California's Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, as amended, and as otherwise known as "Proposition 65", requires businesses manufacturing or distributing products to inform persons about exposures to chemicals in the products that are known to the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm. Proposition 65 contains more than 900 chemicals that the State has listed as having these effects, if the exposure is above threshold levels.

Based on information provided to us by our suppliers, the chemicals which are alloyed into the products that we distribute are in a physiologically inert and stable phase, and should be considered non-hazardous. Certain fabrication or welding processes may result in the emission of chemical substances that could potentially be hazardous. Given that High Temp Metals is not in control and has no oversight in regards to down stream processing, we can only urge our customers to make their own assessment as to the potential hazards based on their fabrication and material alteration requirements.
